



Stay Safe Online!

SECURITY

- Make sure you have antivirus protection and that it's up-to-date.
- Be aware of SCAMS – sometimes people might trick you to get your money or private information.
- Don't download anything without asking permission from an adult first.
- Don't open emails or links from people you don't know – these could be viruses!
- Learn how to screenshot – to “keep the evidence” if something goes wrong.
- Only use websites that are secure, familiar and have a good reputation.

PRIVACY

- Don't talk to people you don't know.
- Keep your password secret.
- Don't give out any personal information that could identify or locate you.
- Check the privacy settings of any accounts you have (social media, games, etc.) to make sure they are set to “private”.
- Be “share aware” – think before you post! Make sure everything you do online is responsible, respectful and good for your reputation.
- **Remember, what you put online may be public and hard to remove!**
