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Personal and Social Capability Learning Continuum Year 7 - 10

Understand relationships

Level 5 – identify indicators of possible problems in relationships in a range of social and work related situations

Level 6 - explain how relationships differ between peers, parents, teachers and other adults, and identify the skills needed to manage different types of relationships

Communicate Effectively

Level 5 – analyse enablers of and barriers to effective verbal, nonverbal and digital communication

Level 6 - formulate plans for effective communication (verbal, nonverbal, digital) to complete complex tasks

Negotiate and resolve conflict

Level 5 – assess the appropriateness of various conflict resolution strategies in a range of social and work-related situations

Level 6 - generate, apply and evaluate strategies such as active listening, mediation and negotiation to prevent and resolve interpersonal problems and conflicts

Examine values

Level 5 – assess the relevance of beliefs and the role and application of values in social practices

Intercultural Understanding Learning Continuum Year 7 - 10

Consider and develop multiple perspectives

Level 5 - assess diverse perspectives and the assumptions on which they are based

Level 6 - present a balanced view on issues where conflicting views cannot easily be resolved



Empathise with others

Level 5 - imagine and describe the feelings and motivations of people in challenging situations

Level 6 - recognise the effect that empathising with others has on their own feelings, motivations and actions

Challenge stereotypes and prejudices

Level 5 – identify and address challenging issues in ways that respect cultural diversity and the right of all to be heard

Level 6 - recognise the challenges and benefits of living and working in a culturally diverse society and the role that cultural mediation plays in learning to live together

Communicating and interacting for health and wellbeing

- Investigate the benefits of relationships and examine their impact on their own and others' health and wellbeing
- Analyse factors that influence emotions, and develop strategies to demonstrate empathy and sensitivity
